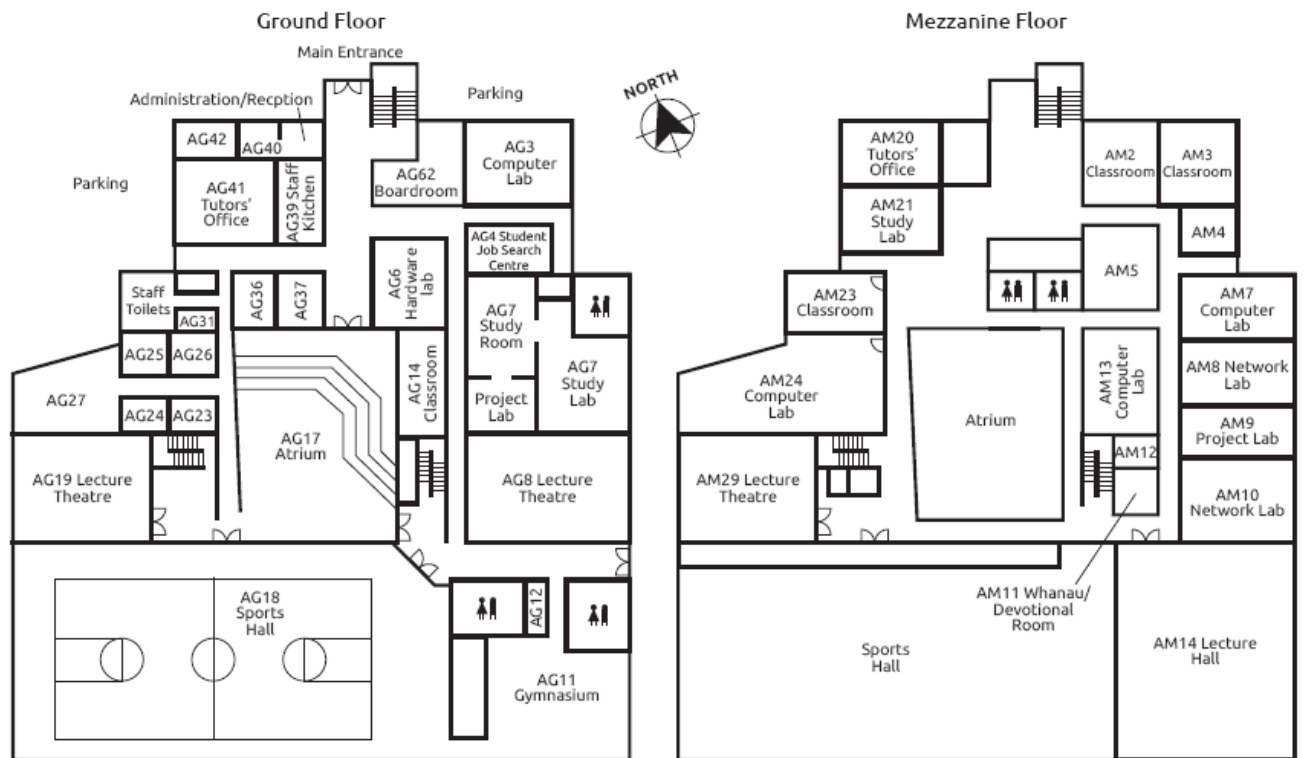
These exams will be held in different rooms at the Asquith Campus.

IMPORTANT EXAM INFORMATION

**Bring your ID CARD to all exams – please check the expiry date on your card
and have your card renewed if necessary
NO ID = NO ADMITTANCE to the exam**

Mobile Phone and Other Electronic Devices and Watches (digital and analogue)

- Switch it off
- Put it in your bag or give it to the exam supervisor at the door
- **If you are found with a phone, watch or other device on your person during the exam this is considered cheating even if it is switched off. A penalty will be applied which may be zero marks for the exam or a reduction in marks for the exam, plus a major demerit point.**

Pencil Cases

- Remove the pens, pencils, ruler, eraser, white ink that you require from your pencil case
- Do not take your pencil case to the table where you are sitting
- **Please bring more than one pen**

Caps

- Remove your cap and put in your bag or leave it with the exam supervisor at the door

Dictionaries

- You are **NOT ALLOWED** to bring a dictionary into the exam room
- If you need to use a dictionary during the exam please ask a supervisor for one – not all courses permit the use of dictionaries.

Calculators

- If you need to use a calculator for your course please bring your own – we cannot provide calculators for students
- Only calculators that lie FLAT on the desk are permitted
- Calculators with an angled display are **NOT ALLOWED**
- Calculators with graphic display, text-storing function, built-in word processing, dictionary function or with the ability to communicate electronically with any other devices are specifically forbidden.

NO Personal Digital Assistants (PDAs) or Removable Drives are allowed to be brought into any exam room.

Practical Exam by using laptop

- Students may only use their AIS-issued laptop.
- Students may not use a wireless mouse.

Cheating Includes:

- Having notes in electronic devices, written on paper, on your hand or any other part of your body.
- Looking at another student's work.
- Helping another student.
- Trying to access websites and applications other than those specified in the exam or exam instructions.
- Talking to another student in the exam room.
- Having a cell phone or other electronic device with you (put it in your bag or give it to an exam supervisor before the start of the exam).

If you are caught cheating you will have to appear before the Student Disciplinary Committee – no exceptions!!
